## MINUTES

### General:

- 1.) Welcome letters were sent to all new property owners.
- 2.) Mark Salveti spoke with Steve Roberts. Our donation for the May Crawfishman Triathlon will be \$500.00. Mr. Salveti asked if they could have a YOLO Board ("You Only Live Once" standup paddling) event to be held in October, 2014. It would be on a much smaller scale than the Crawfishman Triathlon.
