2021 ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING



This is to formally notify all members that the Annual Meeting of the membership for electing the Board of Managers and approval of the 2021 Annual Budget will be held on **SATURDAY**, **JANUARY 30**, **2021**, at **12:00 NOON**. The meeting location will be at the Bush Fire Station on Hwy. 21.

To maintain social distancing, the meeting will be held in the area that the fire trucks are stored.

The Association's books will be available for inspection at 10:00 a.m. until meeting time and after the membership meeting, if necessary.

Personalized ballots will be mailed in January. Please mail your ballots in early to avoid delivery after the date of the meeting. Your vote **will not** be counted if it arrives after January 30th. Hand delivered ballots must be received by 10:00 a.m. on the day of the meeting.

We urge you to participate in the election process to approve the budget

and elect a board of managers, as a meeting cannot be held unless a quorum is reached. Submission of a ballot is what determines a quorum. YOUR VOTE MATTERS.

As in past years, counting of the ballots will begin at 10:00 a.m. by the Election Committee.

2021 PROPOSED BUDGET

After 5-6 years of decreasing and no increased budgets the Proposed Budget for 2021 does have a slight increase for clear reasons. First, let us look back at the Homeowners Association Budgets since 2015.

2015 - \$35,160.00 2016 - \$16,485.00 2017 - \$13,960.00 2018 - \$11,985.00 2019 - \$11,985.00 2020 - \$11,985.00

The Board has remained steadfast in holding each and every expense at a minimum and worked every way possible to keep our dues at the lowest not just in St. Tammany Parish but the entire state of Louisiana. This year, with an increase, we will still be the lowest or one of the lowest.

For 2021, the Proposed Budget is \$13,985.00. This increase is primarily covered in a few areas. The largest increase is in taking care of the grounds and grass on all common This includes the front areas. entrance, median, and the boat landing. This year will include the lake dam. In years past we have had members of the Association donate their time, expense and wear and tear on their equipment to mow the dam area. There has been the additional concern of liability and insurance for our members. This increase in the 2021 Budget will include the dam area, as well as taking more detailed care and upkeep of the boat landing shrubbery, and the front and rear entrance gardens.

Another budget line increase is in the website domain and technology. This will primarily be changing the Association's records and financial information into this century and making everything quicker, better, and modern as opposed to the harder hand work methods used for too long. There is some additional startup cost in making this transition.

The other budget line item with an increase is on the Washington/St. Tammany electrical cost. This is planning on slightly higher utility costs, as well as the additional lighting cost for the front entrance sign and seasonal lighting.

The other budget lines are basically the same or have a decrease. This slight increase in the 2021 Budget only amounts to an additional \$1.59 per acre, thus the cost per acre on the proposed budget is \$11.14 per acre.

We do believe that this slight increase is well worth the added values to our beautiful community and ask for your support in voting YES/APPROVAL on the 2021 Budget.

As always, the Board will continue to work diligently to reduce and keep cost to a minimum while working at the same time to continue to improve one of the most special places on earth to call home.

Due to COVID-19, the triathlon was not held this year.

SOLAR LIGHTING REAR ENTRANCE

Solar lighting has been installed on the rear entrance sign and when illuminated it looks great. Due to the

position of the sign facing north and the tree line, we are experiencing battery recharging issues, even with an additional solar panel. We are working with the solar light company to resolve this issue.



LAKE COMMITTEE

The Lake Committee has successfully completed the better part of the first 3 phases of their plan which included creating a new fish habitat in the lake and stocking the lake on two separate occasions, in 2019 and 2020, with various species of bait fish (minnows, shad, bream) and also catfish and bass.

In mid 2021, the Lake Committee will have achieved 2 full years since their work began and hopefully during the year start, to see the full results of the initial work. That being a self-sustaining food chain provided by our smaller foraging fish that spawn multiple times during the year and then a noticeable improvement in the size of our pan fish, bass, and catfish. Hopefully, the fishing will be improved and provide more opportunities for all age groups fishing in the lake.

2021 Phase 4 plans:

- Allow additional fishing in lake by our members and harvesting of new bass per posted modified slot limits.
- Continue monitoring fish activity and harvest results.
- Stock additional fathead minnows and bass as budget constraints allow, if needed.

One thing we have learned from our first two years is that we need additional fish habitat in the lake and will continue adding that through

creative ways to build it and through Christmas tree donations.

The Lake Committee will provide an outline of slot limit guidelines to post at the lake and publish in the newsletter for the property owners. Hopefully, through our monitoring process and the results in fish harvesting, we will see firsthand or reported by members, so we can determine if additional stocking of selected fish species is warranted during the year. Or, if we should just allow an additional year of maturation for what we have already completed.

Please note:

It was suggested by the committee that if any landowner who lives on the lake wants to dredge the shoreline of their property to contact either a committee member or the Board prior to the project. Considering the issues of improving fish habitat and restocking our lake, dredging the shoreline may need to take place at certain times of the year.

The Association appreciates the lake committee members' continued dedication to the improvement of our lake



The lake committee wants your Christmas tree. Please place your Christmas tree (without any flocking, tinsel, or lights) in the boat launch area by 1/18/2021. The collected trees will be recycled to supply a habitat for the fish.
